Cascade Clamps - Founded in Portland, Oregon in 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company began as a small machine store employing just four individuals. Overall sales for that initial year amounted to about sixty thousand dollars. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless-steel valves, pipe fittings and different components. Within 5 years of operation, the company had expanded to 40 workers and their annual sales volume had increased to three hundred thirty thousand dollars. Today, Cascade is amongst the top global producers within the material handling industry.

Design and manufacturing of the company's first hydraulic cylinder allowed this young company to aggressively pursue new business opportunities. All through the last sixty years, the industry of material handling has grown into a very advanced area with Cascade proudly playing a part in its progress. Cascade at present continues to develop as the leader supplier of forklift attachments and various related products. The company feels confident in their capability so as to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding client's requirements in the future and remaining competitive within the global market.

All through the 1950's, Cascade started to manufacture, design, and sell its hydraulic attachments. A brand new facility was built in the year 1956, so as to accommodate all the plant offices and operations in Portland, Oregon, which remains to be the company's current headquarters. After fifteen years of business, total employees reached 180 staff and sales had reached practically \$2,300,000.

A second production plant was built in the year 1959 in Springfield, Ohio. 1960 marked Cascade's preliminary transfer into the international world of the material handling industry when the business established interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

In the year 1964, the company altered its name to the Cascade Corporation. Then in 1965, the business went public with a preliminary offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Since then the business has expanded its manufacturing services throughout the continental US to the locations Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already present plants in Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Ohio. Cascade products are manufactured worldwide thanks to a lot of subsidiary operations. In 1994, a brand new plant was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European head office. This facility is designed to be the ultimate customer support centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and the year 1997 after buying five corporations, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the global leader in blades.
